


Cell Phone Bluetooth in a Miata

It is difficult to use most Cell Phone Bluetooth devises in a top down Miata. After some experimenting, I found a set up that actually works. I used the "Jabra Cruiser" model Bluetooth that has the clip to hook on your sun visor, but made a small modification to make it work in the Miata. I thought I would stray away from the mechanical things this month and do something some of you might find useful. As I drive my car every day, this is very useful for me.

Take a look at picture #1 below. This is the front of the Jabra I used. Picture 2 is the back with the hook removed. There are 4 small screws, one in each corner. I removed them and the hook was easy to take off. You can also see where I put the "Hook" side of the Velcro in the middle of the unit.

Picture 3 shows how I put a piece of Velcro fuzzy side on the top of the steering wheel hub. This easily holds the Jabra Bluetooth as it is very light. Plus with Velcro holding it, it is easy to take off when not in the car. I just remove it and stick it to the carpet between the center tunnel and my seat.

Picture 4 shows the Jabra mounted on the steering wheel center hub, and picture 5 shows it up on the visor. With the top up I stick it up on the visor, and with the top down I stick it on the steering wheel hub. This really works, and is simple to do.
